Our family has been comforted by the many condolences that have come to us as we mourn the passing of our daughter, Sarah Catherine Woodward. September 11 was the day she was unexpectedly taken from this life, apparently due to a pulmonary embolism. Shock, grief, mourning...

On September 15, Linda and I were given extra grace to have private time at the funeral home "with her" as we prayed, read Scripture, sang, worshiped and said our temporary goodbyes.

The Celebration of Life service at our home church in Pigeon Forge, TN was very meaningful and consoling. So many relatives and friends were able to attend and encourage us. Linda and I wanted to provide a solo and a



devotional message, but opted to pre-record them so we would hopefully be more composed. The technology cooperated, so the videos were included. Linda sang "Blessings" and I gave a testimonial message about Sarah, the plan of salvation, and the provision of grace for daily living. How are we doing? The grief journey continues, as it does for all of us who have loved ones who have passed on ... But we have received so many "grace tokens": a behind-the-scenes report that first responders reached Sarah in time to witness her last two breaths; she was not alone and didn't suffer. Linda found written prayers of Sarah, asking to be delivered from her chronic pain. The assurance of heaven is all the more precious. We have been blessed by cards, meals, emails, texts, bouquets, and more. God has provided supernatural comfort and peace.

We had prayed that Sarah's service would be used of the Lord in the lives of those who attended and others who view the videos. We are receiving reports that He is blessing the song and message in the lives of family and friends here and in distant lands. We carry the consolation of the hymns that we sang: *Amazing Grace* and *Great is Thy Faithfulness*.
