The Scripture quotation about **God's love** relates to this observation from an unknown devotional writer: "If we get a wrong idea about the inward working of the Cross we shall lose our own enjoyment of God's love and fail to manifest that love to others. We have no doubt that, for the sinner, the Cross is the outstanding expression of God's love [Rom. 5:8], but when we realize that it brings us, as believers, into a very personal experience of being crucified together with Christ, we are apt to lose sight of the love of God...[But] The Cross will always bring us back to the love of God in ever-increasing fulness [Eph. 3:18-20]." Amen.

I had special opportunities during the recent trip to **New Jersey** to share the fuller message of the Cross and celebrate God's transformative grace and love. On the morning of June 3rd I was at The Colony of Mercy at America's Keswick. (We have had their chaplains come to Tennessee for training and I have been there a few times over the years.) This recovery ministry was started by Cherri Freeman's great grandfather. She lives nearby and we had a good catch-up visit.

The "hybrid" Workshop (online and in-person teaching) worked out wonderfully. About 18 people from Bayside Chapel enrolled in the online content and met on six Monday nights with pastors Joe Faraldi and Ken Carlson. The concluding inperson event was Friday night and Saturday, June 3,4. Two other couples from out of state attended and the Lord gave us special fellowship and interaction. I anticipate using this hybrid model again with other like-minded churches.

Regarding **new publications**, my book *Blessed Reassurance* has just been published in Spanish--*Bendita Seguridad*. I am sending sample copies to the translator and others to review this paperback edition. And John Best's book, *The Cross of Christ* has now been published in paperback.

On June 7th I spent the day with Steve (from Chattanooga) and Pradeep (visiting from **Nepal**). They had walked through the online Workshop content together and then we had this day of fellowship and additional teaching at GFI.

Thank you again for your prayers and financial support. May our experience of the Cross unveil new dimensions of God's enablement, grace and love.
