Any excuse for cake is fine with me :-). I had the opportunity to drive to my sister's home in Georgia October 4-5 for a family get-together. I'm also happy to report that our youngest twin grandson, Levi, continues to grow and improve.

Here at GFI we are staying busy with counseling as people call us from across the country requesting counseling, usually on a daily basis. What a privilege to provide Christ-centered counseling and training in these difficult days.

We are so grateful for God's faithfulness. The years fly by; I have served here at GFI now for 23 years. We are very thankful for our support team and intercessors. May you continue to be blessed with God's perfect peace.
